Treasurer's Report	 MM reported that cash flow projections are not up to snuff May financials are 13.85% in cash down YTD relative to last year About a \$50k deficit at this time TS has action plans to hopefully narrow that gap significantly in the next month TS reported that we've been making larger chapter payouts this year than last year (126 vs. 110) due to increased YTD memberships TS has crunched numbers and sees potential for \$20-\$25k deficit but is optimistic for strong second half
