Administrative Overview	Jan 27 Minutes:	
Budget	Revenues: Tom has built in conservative growth across all membership categories. These numbers should be attainable, with specific effort being put on individual members; An ongoing cap/post cap discussion will impact these numbers for the better (once put in action). This budget can be approved prior to the adjusted structure being put in place. Tom is progressing conversations with the Chapters regarding this topic. The Grant category increased due to 2019 Naming Grant commitments being paid in 2020. This cycle will likely occur in future years as well; General Donations and Annual Fund Donations: this category decreased from a goal of \$50K in 2019 to \$18.5K in 2020. This is a much more feasible goal and should be obtainable through BOD fundraising efforts. The fundraising committee put together a multi-prong fundraising approach, which should make this goal achievable. 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	Expenses: Per Tom's performance review, his salary increased to \$71,500; All other salary related expenses remained the same. There are no new additions to this category, last year we added the full time PM position, which was a large adjustment. Legal consulting is up \$4,800 - this is due to increase lobbying work at the state level. This is important work at this time. We want to be able to provide support in the future.
